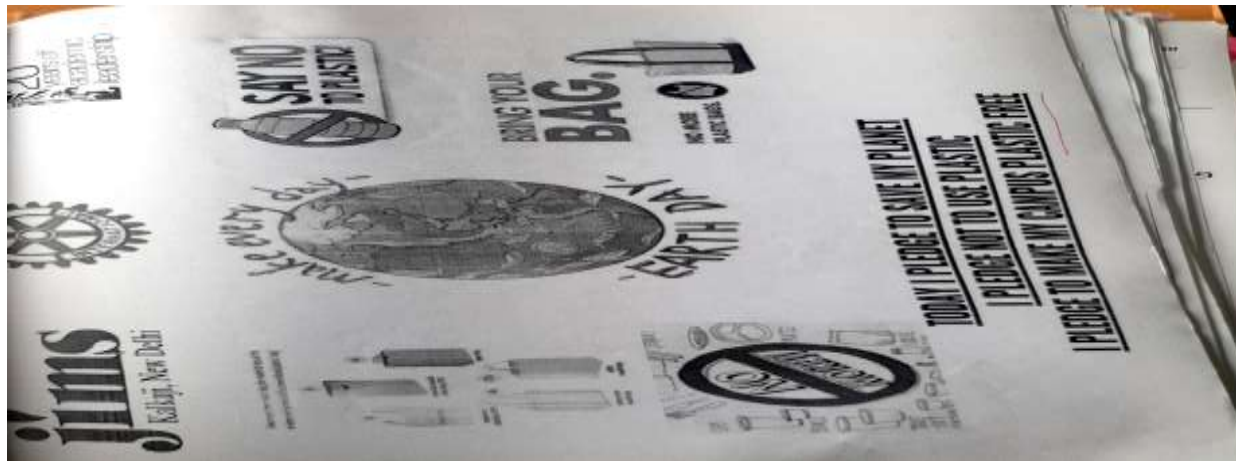

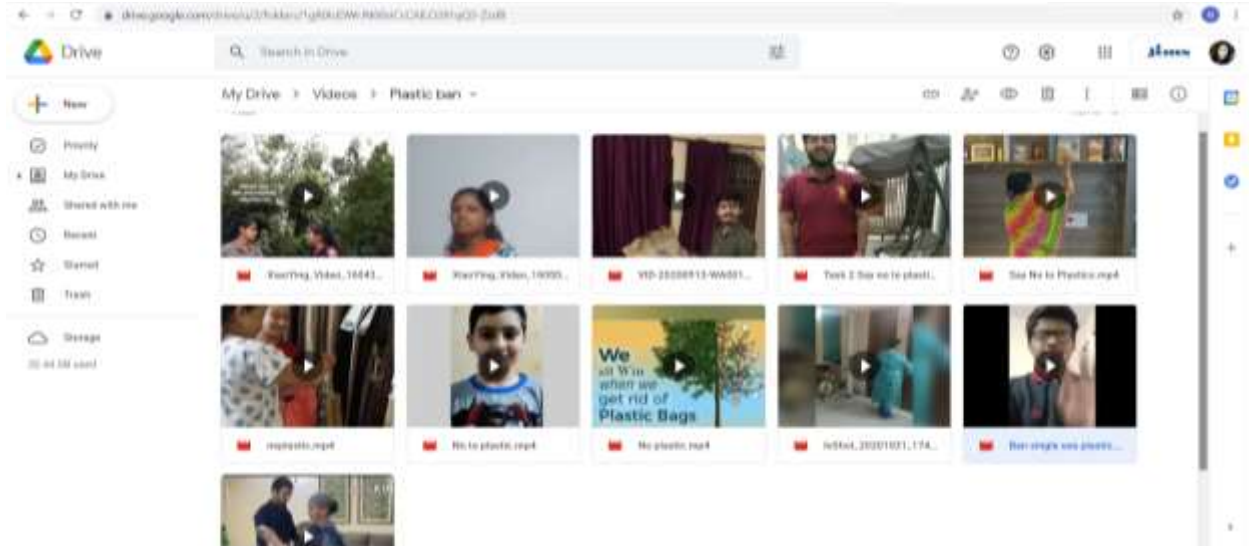
A campaign was started to Ban the use of plastic in the institute by students of Rotaract Club wherein students pledged to not use plastic especially the single use plastic.

The focus was to spread awareness amongst people about the harmful effects of using plastic and persuading them to quit using it.

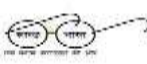

LANDSCAPING WITH TREES AND PLANTS

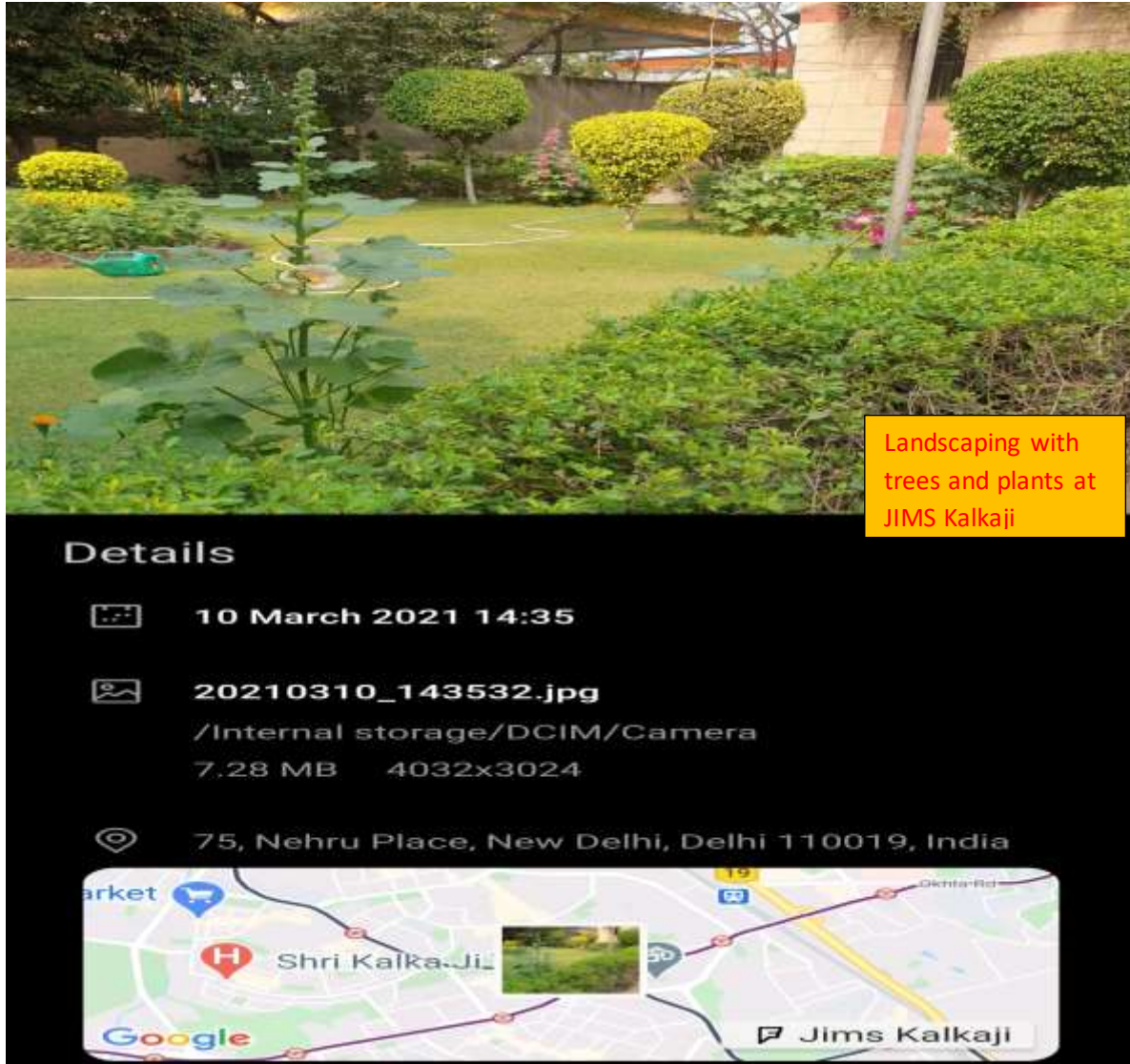
There are a number of plants and trees planted in the institute. Following is the list of the same:
