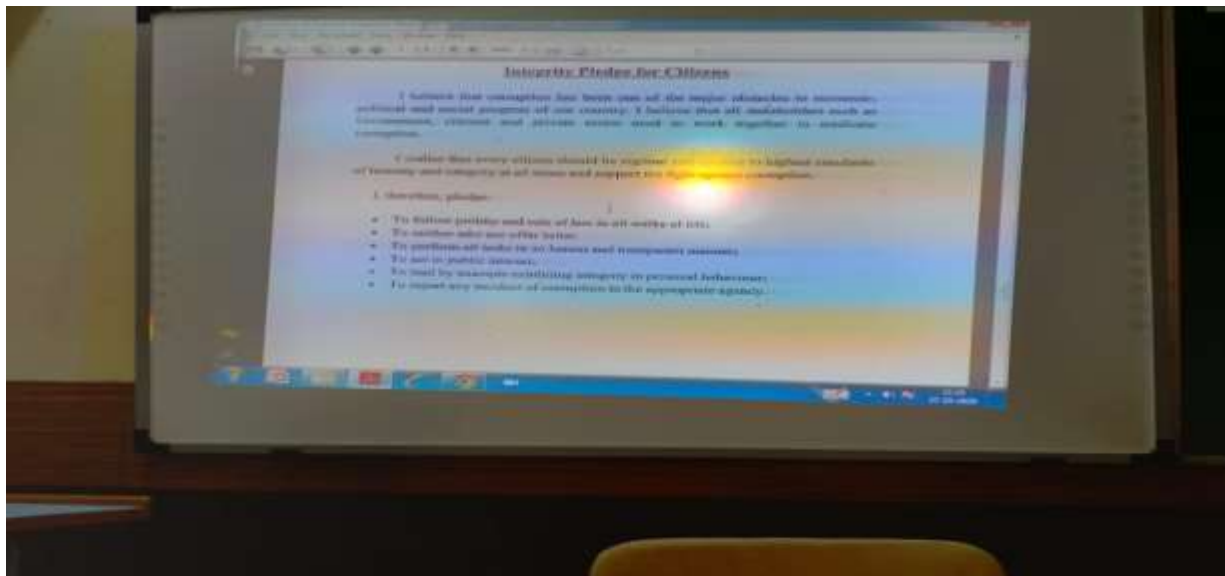

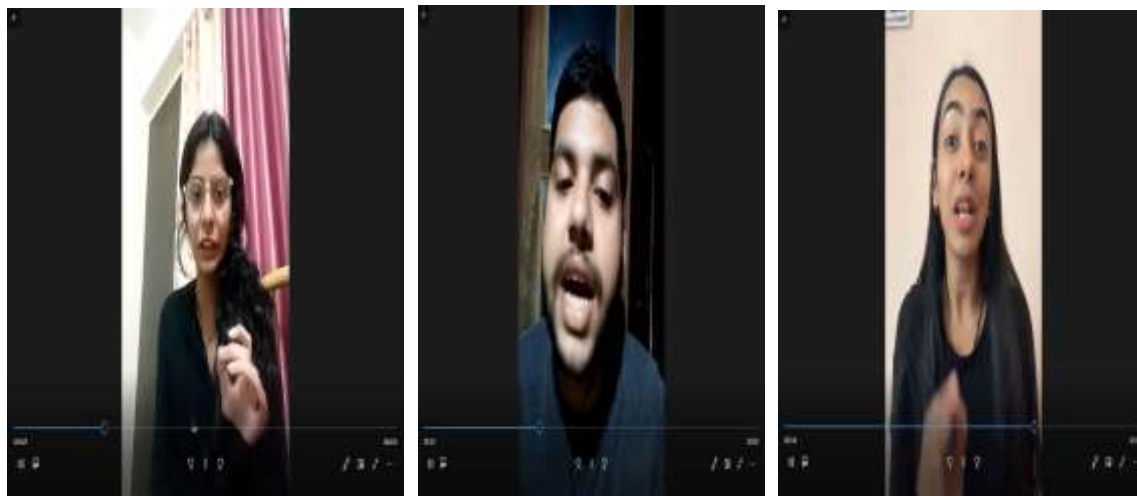
DEBATE COMPETITION ON CORRUPTION

1st position: Mayank Nanda BBA IInd year

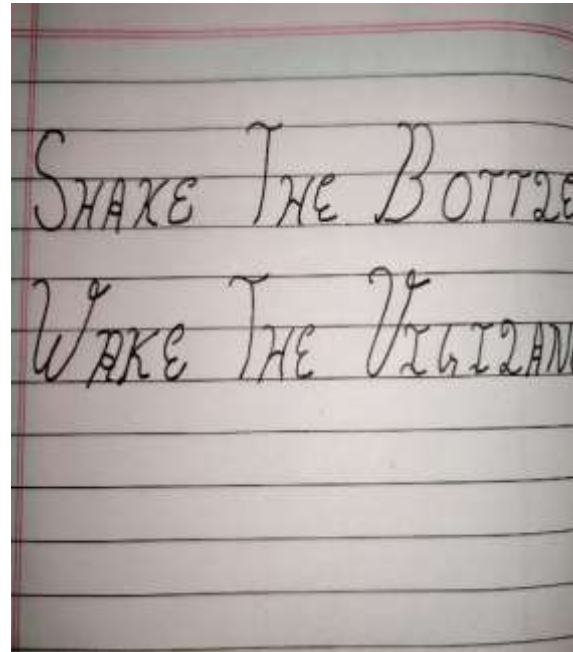
2nd position: Kanika Guliya BBA IInd year

First position: Prachi Deo, BBA IInd year

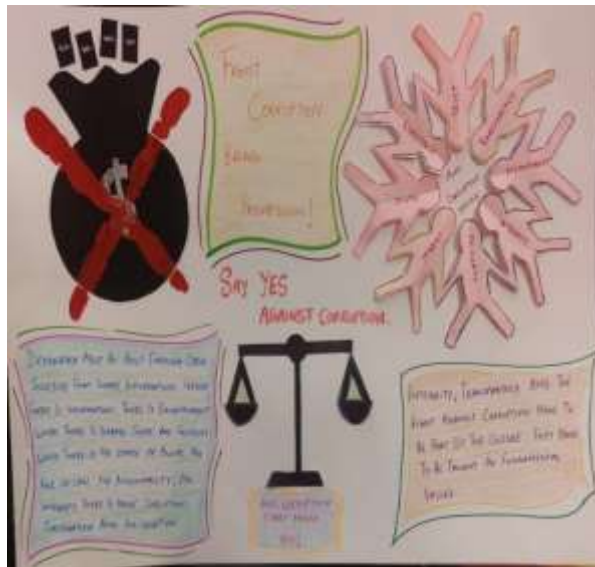
Second position: Divyanshu Singh, BBA IInd year

QUIZ ON CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

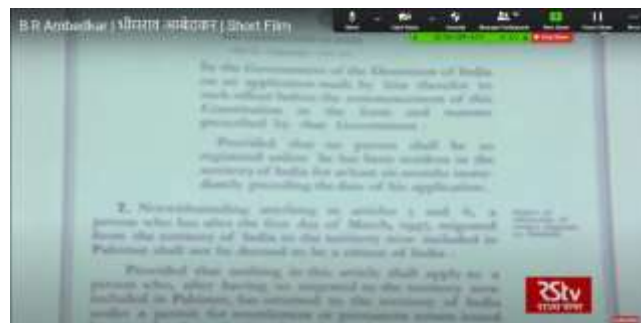
