
From Chairman's Desk

JIMS VK I: Diwali Celebrations 2025







JIMS VKI: NSS celebrated Constitution Month





JIMS Kalkaji: National Seminar




JIMS VK II: Industry Visit to Odyssey Stone Factory


JIMS VK I: Session on Timeless Innovation in Computer Organization


